Worship with us this Sunday, June 21

The sermon is titled *Reading the Bible with Faith*. Meredith Schroeer, who will deliver the sermon, asks us to ponder these questions: Is the Bible a static book? Are all its verses set in stone? Or are the Scriptures dynamic, even sometimes revisiting and reconsidering earlier texts? And how can we read and understand the Biblical texts which, honestly, confound us? Sunday's sermon, which looks first at Peter's watershed experience in Acts 10, will reflect on these questions. The hymns are *Open Now Thy Gates of Beauty* (HWB 19), *God of the Bible* (STJ 27), *This is a Story Full of Love* (HWB 315) and *God is Working His Purpose Out* (HWB 638).

- 1 package sanitary pads (18-24 count thin maxi)
