True Story of the Whole World Into All the World (Lesson 15) is this week's Adult and Teen Christian Education lesson. Scripture Focus We begin our worship service with a Scripture Focus each week that comes from the congregational study of the Bible in which we are currently engaged. Each worship service is based on the lesson from the previous week's Sunday School study.

A Word about our Worship Visuals Quilters have named blocks after Bible stories for generations. The Bible was the primary literary resource in many early American homes, providing inspiration for nineteenth century quilters, who mostly used scraps and outgrown clothing beyond repair to sew covers to keep their loved ones warm. Throughout our True Story study series, a variety of quilt blocks representing Bible stories or themes will be presented. Here is a description of the visual display for April 24.

Cross and Crown - Hebrews 12:2

Five different designs have had this title throughout the years. Each one is based on a corner motif separated by intersecting bands. All five have the same simple meaning - Jesus died for us, and now reigns in our hearts!

- 1 hand towel (dark color)


